**START**

Put your mouse arrow on **START** at the bottom of the maze found on Page 1. Use your mouse to move your way out of the maze. Each time you come to attitudes and actions that lead to responsible citizenship, put a number in the text box next to the matching statement on the worksheet.

For example:

You arrive at the first attitude and action on the maze -- enter a number 1 next to the matching attitude and action on the worksheet.

Then you arrive at the second attitude and action on the maze -- enter a number 2 next to the matching attitude and action on the worksheet.

If an attitude and action on the maze doesn't lead to responsible citizenship, leave the text box next to the matching attitude and action on the worksheet blank.
